many there, and we'll do everything possible to encourage their presence. Our next big event will be the Nobility Ball on Saturday, May 4th. Look for it to


Tickets will be available through the office, and RSVP's will be required to maximize the experience and value. More live entertainment will be the highlight!

# Message from the Recorder

Nobles, Ladies and Friends,

Spring is definitely in the air. With the longer daylight, the bulbs are pushing their flowers up and out to welcome the time. It might be a little premature based on the cold we are experiencing right

We made it through the winter months with a few new projects from the effects of the weather. One project is the picnic area bathrooms where we had a water pipe freeze and burst. This will require assessing the effects of the water behind the drywall and impact from any wet

insulation. After repairing the pipe, we will have to replace drywall and insulate the ceiling so the pipes are better protected from frigid temperatures. Once that is complete, we will have to paint the walls and ceiling where we replaced drywall.

With the latest burglary suffered by the Nile, we have implemented systems to protect our Shrine Center. We removed the ATM from our lobby. Although the convenience is gone, so is the motivation to break in and try to steal the cash machine. We installed a new front gate system. The system has a video camera that we can see the individual asking for entrance and speak to them. We can operate the gate from the administrator's cell phone to open temporarily. The system also allows us to establish individual access codes for all of our members, caterers, grounds crew, garbage collectors and anyone else who needs access. We can track the access codes and associate access with who is assigned the code. Effective March 1st, nobles will need to use their member number. Member numbers have already been established for all of you when you

became a Shriner. If you still have the physical membership card, your member number is printed on the card. WebFez is the other place you can find your member number. If you need your member number, you can also contact the office.

The apartment restoration is moving right along. The exterior siding and restoration is almost complete. The roofers will be out this week to replace the roof that has been removed to perform the repairs. The work will be moving inside after that.

May 17th is coming soon and that is the date of the joint Shriners Children's Hospital 100-year celebration Golf Tournament for Portland and Spokane. We are fortunate to be spotlighted for this event. You will hear more details as we get closer and have the chance to sign up or volunteer if you are interested. We will need your help and it would be great to have you there.

Our year so far has been busy. We are continuing to go after various projects that will shape the Nile Shrine Center as the premier golf and event center in the north end of town. I hope many of you feel the same and can appreciate the changes taking place. We are also concentrating on providing our membership the benefits of being a Nile member with some of the projects being worked on. It's through the hard work, support and dedication of many of you volunteers that help make things happen around here and I truly appreciate it. Without you, we would not be accomplishing what we need and want for the Nile. A big thank you to everyone.

I will see you soon. I am counting on it. Especially as the season changes. Until then, take care, give your love to those you have close to you, and we will catch up when we catch up!

should be submitted to the Nile Shrine Office. (Forms may be submitted electronically, as an Excel or Word attachment. Please send to: office@nileshriners.org)

Crown of Honor Awards must be earned by each noble. Points will not be given away, and awards will not be traded or purchased from another noble. Nobles who submit for points not earned will become ineligible to participate in this program.

A noble may inquire at any time as to how many points he has earned to date. Points accumulate from year to year and are recorded in the WEBFEZ database; the full amount for any award level need not be earned in any single year.


