We've had to cancel many events and hopefully, we will soon be able to reschedule not only the monthly meetings but some of the parades and social events.

Message from the Treasurer

Hello Nobles,
Great news our PPP loan for the holding company was fully forgiven in May, 2021. I am working with our CPA's to properly record this in our accounting system. The Recorder and I, with guidance from our CPA's, have found close to \$200,000.00 worth of bills paid by the Temple that should have been paid by the Holding company. In the past, this was not a problem, but in 2020, the Holding company made a profit after expenses of more than \$400,000.00. This created a big federal tax problem for us and so we started looking for expenses that should have been paid by the Holding instead of the Temple. This movement of expenses resulted in a reduction of our federal tax liability by over \$60,000.00. All of our records are sent into the CPA's for our tax

preparation and I expect this to be filed with the IRS and Imperial in July or August.

Our roof project is underway as far as scheduling is concerned and is going to start on September 6, 2021 and should last about 6 weeks. So far we have almost \$100,000.00 committed to this capital fund raising event from the clubs and units and from many nobles who have committed or already donated to this project. Thank all of you for your generous support for this project.

As far as the Holding company is concerned we are having another record year from the golf course and as of the end of May we are up over \$300,000.00 over last year which was a record year for us. The Catering company is starting to book events, and we are moving forward with the Haunt this year. If we can continue to have this success, we will be up for a banner year.

That is all I have at the moment, and I thank you for your continued support of the Nile.

larger operation. Your efforts are recognized by all of us. It is appreciated and thanks go to all of you!

In these promising times there are those around us struggling with their health conditions and illnesses. We hear from our Nobles and friends about many of you and how you are currently doing. We wish we could do more and if we can, know that we will try anything you think you may need to help. Please let us know how you are doing and our heartfelt best wishes go out to you all.

Our clubs and units are beginning to meet again. The MW Grand Master has lifted his COVID guidelines but we are still bound to CDC and our Governor’s COVID guidelines. With the relaxing of restrictions and increased activities, we are all looking to help our causes and achieve our organizations goals. I know units are looking to raise monies for the SHC needs and their unit/club needs too. The Nile is doing the same. We need a new roof and work will begin on that project this September. We have also committed to a \$5,000 fund raiser for the Portland SHC Outreach Clinic. Of the \$5,000, \$3,000 funds the outreach clinic needs directly. \$2,000 will be used for the purchase of a Tryke and 30 helmets. Here’s a picture of the Tryke:



The Tryke is peddled using your hands and arms versus your legs. It is provided to patient children that cannot use their legs to peddle and provides an opportunity for them to be kids and have fun.

Helmets are provided to them as well. The \$2,000 covers the cost of the Tryke and 30 helmets. If you are interested in donating, please make checks out to **Portland SHC** and in the note section write **Nile Outreach Clinic Fundraiser**.

The Nile hospital patient transportation fund as I have covered with you before is very healthy. We have implemented the administration and funding of the patient support for all of Western Washington by taking over the support for the Affi territory. The transition went smoothly, and we are looking for other opportunities to help with patient support in the northwest. One of our advantages that we bring to the table is the daily operation at the Nile. We have an operation and personnel that can be available for support on a regular basis.

Finally, we are headed into summer where we are dark with commitments of meetings and formal functions for the Nile, and our units and clubs. However, this feels different than traditional years where we are dark. There is much to catch up with and prepare for later this year, and we will be able to actually do more than we have for a year. It is an exciting time given just that prospect alone. I do miss all of you and know we will be back together in the near future. We will share old and new stories and enjoy the camaraderie and libations of choice while we do. I look forward to that time with you more than you can imagine. Until that day, stay safe and take care.

Nile Shriners Bylaws Amendments 2021

Whereas Shriners International uses the spelling of “bylaws” and Nile Shriners has used the spelling as “by-laws”, to conform to the usage by Shriners International.

And Whereas the modern accepted and sometimes considered correct spelling is “bylaws”.

Be it now resolved that all appearances of “by-laws” be changed to “bylaws” throughout.

Whereas Nile Catering Corporation no longer exists, there is no need to develop any budgets for this entity.

Be it now resolved that Article V, DUTIES OF NILE SHRINERS OFFICERS, BOARD OF DIRECTORS be amended to read:

ARTICLE V

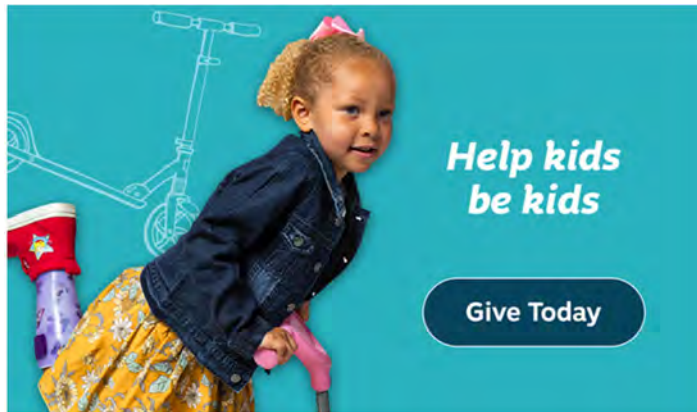
Multiple Budgets. Budgets shall be submitted for the following:

- Nile Shriners Operating Budget
- Nile Shriners Capital Budget
- Nile Holding Corporation Operating Budget
- Nile Holding Corporation Capital Budget
- ~~Nile Catering Corporation Operating Budget~~
- ~~Nile Catering Corporation Capital Budget~~

Whereas the Life Membership portion of the current bylaws shall be modified to align with the Bylaws of Shriners International, its provisions and requirements. Shriners International Bylaws (Iowa) § 332.6, (a), (4).

Be it now resolved that Article IX LIFE MEMBERSHIPS, SECTION 1, Paragraph C. be amended to read:

- C. Payment of a lump-sum equivalent to ten (10) years dues to the Recorder by a member in good standing who is sixty-five (65) years of age or older. All money received from Life Memberships shall be placed in a ~~trust~~ *perpetual* fund, and only the income from such fund shall be withdrawn and *used* for the operating expenses of the temple. *Upon the death of a life member, an amount equal to the sum paid by him may be transferred to the operating fund.*



Nobles, Ladies and Friends,

The Portland SHC Outreach Clinic has been canceled for in-person sessions. Here's their explanation:

"The plan for this outreach was to move forward with scheduling patients, with the knowledge that we may need to convert patients to telehealth depending on the current COVID restrictions. Many of the Bellingham patients travel from Canada, and because patients cannot travel across the border easily, volume was very low for this clinic,

and we opted to cancel. The handful of patients that were scheduled were rescheduled for video visits at a time that was convenient for them.

The costs to the hospital associated with the Telehealth visits (with a doctor and additional staff) are what we are asking to be covered by your fundraiser."

The need for funding this ongoing effort still exists. Our commitment for the \$5,000 fundraiser will move forward until we reach our goal.

The \$5,000 we raise will be used for a couple of needs Portland SHC Outreach has. The specific priorities I have been told are:

\$ 3,000 The Bellingham Outreach Clinic

\$ 2,000 Purchase of a Tryke bike

Here's more detail about the Tryke bike program provided by Portland SHC:

"The Tryke bike request is for our Recreational Rehab program. Tryke bikes are used in our hospital's adaptive bike loan program – so patients have the opportunity to borrow a trike that is adapted for their physical needs.

The bikes are available to loan for 2-4 weeks at a time. Sometimes the families decide to buy one on their own (or, most often, apply for funding for their own). And sometimes (particularly because they might outgrow them quickly) they just borrow them a few times throughout the year.

The request is for a hand pedaled that fits small children. Just like typically developing kids get to ride bikes when they're 2-3yrs old, it's really important that we start offering these options to kids who need more adaptations.

The Tryke bike amount of \$2000 will pay for a bike and also allow for purchase of 30 helmets for the kids to wear when they are riding the bike."



We haven't formalized the fundraiser quite yet and if you want to get involved or if you want to be in charge of the fundraiser, please let me know.

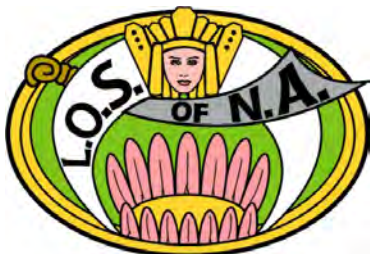
